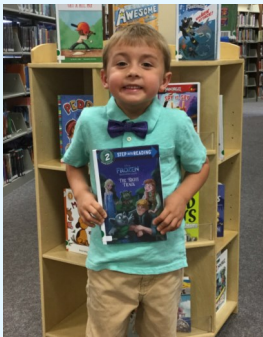

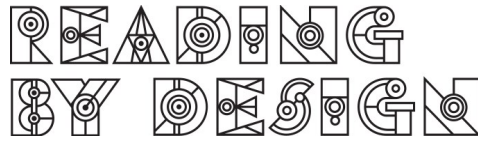

Open to ages 12-14. The design and construction of our first robot continues! No sign up required.



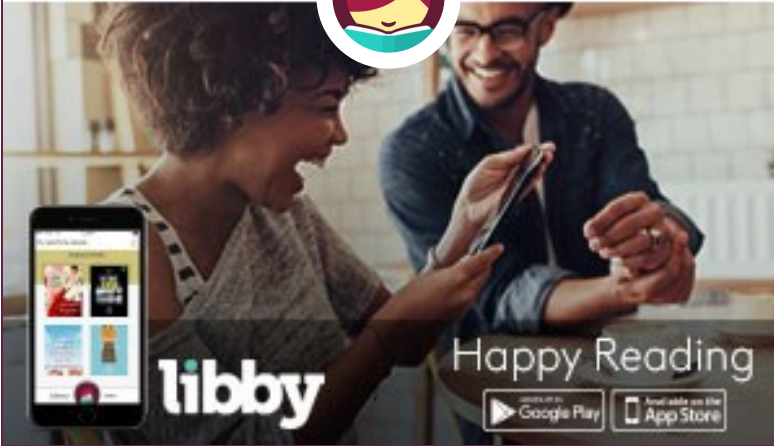
Coming in September...
