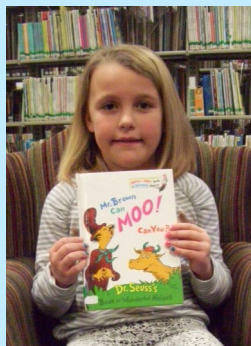

Remember: When you come to the appointment, seniors should bring all related documents for the year's expenses and charitable contributions, real estate bills paid in 2014 and sales tax records if a new car was purchased in 2014. Also, a copy of last year's completed income tax forms and any tax forms received in the mail. Renters will require rent information if they are filing for the Illinois Circuit Breaker.

Tax Forms at Library:

Talcott will have limited tax forms. The library was notified by the IRS and Illinois Department of Revenue that libraries will receive fewer tax forms and publications. No instruction booklets will be sent to libraries.

Students can get free practice ACT/SAT test from Talcott's online research database:

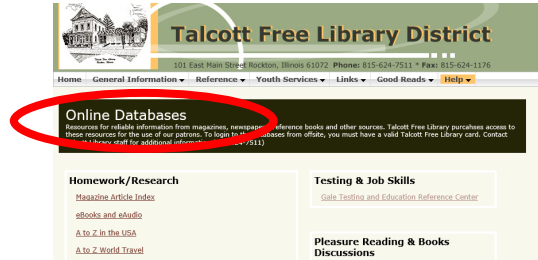
